The Commons Registration (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

The Secretary of State for the Environment, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19(1)(a) of the Commons Registration Act 1965(a), and now vested in them (b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Commons Registration (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 25th March 1982.
- 2. In regulation 35 of the Commons Registration (General) Regulations 1966(c) the words "and no forms of those numbers other than those so supplied shall be used" shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations remove the prohibition on the use of certain forms prescribed under the Commons Registration Act 1965 where the forms are not supplied under arrangements made by Her Majesty's Stationery Office to registration authorities, but are supplied from other sources.
